Hoarafushi features stunning sandy beaches, crystal-clear shallow waters, and a peaceful lagoon surrounded by uninhabited islands—an ideal escape for nature lovers and history seekers.

Kuda Miskiy, an old mosque which people used to pray was believed to be built around 1912. The mosque is now left abandoned as a heritage of the island.

Ziyaaraiy is believed to be the burial site of a religious scholar from around 150 years ago. The islanders have preserved it with deep respect and care ever since
