The North Thiladhunmathi Atoll (Ha. Atoll) is governed by the Secretariat of the Ha. Atoll Council. It is the third-largest atoll in the Maldives in terms of land area and population, comprising 42 islands, only 14 islands remain inhabited. The remaining 28 islands are uninhabited.

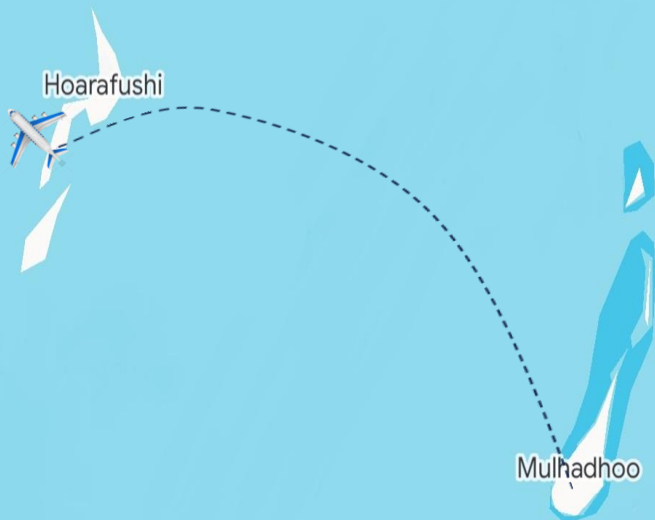

Molhadhoo, an inhabited island in Haa Alif Atoll, is known for its natural beauty, peaceful atmosphere, and rich local culture. Once famous for green sea turtle nesting alongside nearby Gaamathikulhudhoo, the island remains a serene, less-touristed destination. Surrounded by clear waters and vibrant coral reefs, it offers excellent diving and snorkeling. With a small, close-knit community rooted in fishing and traditional Maldivian life, Molhadhoo retains an authentic and environmentally connected charm.



The distance between Haa Alifu Molhadhoo and Haa Alifu Hoarafushi is approximately 7.6 nautical miles (14.1 km). The estimated duration by speedboat, traveling at 30 knots, is around 15 minutes.

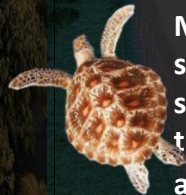

Molhadhoo Reef is renowned for its vibrant marine biodiversity, featuring a wide variety of reef fish and larger species such as grey reef sharks, eagle rays, tuna, and barracudas. The reef's vivid soft corals and crystal-clear waters offer an exceptional snorkelling experience, with sightings of species like the Palette Surgeonfish, bannerfish, oriental sweetlips, and more.

Molhadhoo Eco Park in the Maldives offers a peaceful retreat with diverse flora and fauna, featuring well-maintained pathways for eco-friendly exploration. Whether seeking a break from daily life or wishing to immerse in the island's natural beauty, the park's serene atmosphere and stunning views make it a perfect destination for relaxation and reflection.



Molhadhoo was formerly a significant nesting site for green sea turtles, with over 20,000 turtles nesting on its beaches annually.
