Utheemu is located approximately 6.4 nautical miles (11.9 km) from Haa Dhaalu Hanimaadhoo, with a travel time of about 13 minutes by speedboat at 30 knots—making it easily accessible for both locals and visitors.

It is renowned as the birthplace of Sultan Mohamed Thakurufaanu, a national hero who played a pivotal role in the country's history. Covering an area of 47 hectares, Utheemu has a total population of 1,015—comprising 502 males and 513 females—with 685 residents currently living on the island.

LAND MARKS & LOCAL ATTRACTIONS

Utheemu holds great historical significance in the Maldives as the birthplace of national hero Sultan Mohamed Thakurufaanu. The island is home to several important historical sites associated with his legacy.

Utheemu Ganduvaru

This historic residence was the home of Sultan Mohamed Thakurufaanu. A visit offers insight into traditional Maldivian architecture and the Sultan's life, while also highlighting the island's role in the nation's history.

Kandhuvalu Mosque

This mosque is closely tied to the Thakurufaanu family and is historically notable as the place where the Utheemu brothers offered prayers for victory against the Portuguese.

Kaani Gas Believed to have grown from a kaani wood prop used by the Utheemu brothers in their weaving loom, this tree stands as a symbolic remnant of the island's past.

LOCAL COUSINES & CULTURE

Utheemu is renowned for its cleanliness, pristine sandy beaches, and crystal-clear waters, making it an ideal destination for nature enthusiasts and tourists.

The island is equally known for its warm hospitality. Locals are friendly and welcoming, often going above and beyond to ensure visitors feel at home.

Thatch Weaving

Thatch weaving is a key livelihood for the women of Utheemu, preserving traditional skills passed down through generations.

Kanamadhu Metagandu

Utheemu is renowned for Kanamadhu Metagandu, a traditional sweet made from sea almonds and condensed milk, adding to the island's cultural charm.
